

# CONSTITUTION FOR DALLINGTON RESIDENTS ASSOCIATION INC

## 1. TITLE

Dallington Residents Association Incorporated

## 2. OBJECTS

- a) To establish a community committee to represent all groups and interested parties in the Dallington district
- b) To promote and protect the interests of the district and the community
- c) To be a recognised body to negotiate with the City Council and other authorities where appropriate
- d) To monitor the recreation areas of the district and make representations to ensure needs are met where appropriate
- e) To monitor social needs of the area and make representations to ensure needs are filled where appropriate
- f) To advise and support constituent members in their efforts to provide better services in the area
- g) To provide a co-ordination service for local groups involved in fund raising
- h) To provide information on Dallington to the public
- i) To encourage the beautification of Dallington
- j) To pursue other matters of importance as the executive or an AGM may from time to time decide upon

## 3. MEMBERSHIP

The following shall be eligible for membership:

- a) Any resident within the boundaries
- b) Any organisation or society that is domiciled in Dallington or which represents Dallington

## 4. RESIGNATION OF MEMBERSHIP

Any member or organisation may resign by letter addressed to the Secretary during the year of membership.

## 5. COMMITTEE

- a) The committee shall consist of a minimum of seven members
- b) The committee shall select a chairperson, secretary and treasurer

## 6. RULES

Alterations of any clauses of the constitution may be added to, rescinded, or amended, or any new clause may be inserted by a majority of those members present at an Annual General Meeting or Extraordinary meeting called for that purpose. A duly seconded notice of the motion in writing, shall have been lodged with the Secretary, by a financial member, 14 days prior to the General or Extraordinary meeting being called.
